 Remarks on board Ship Herald of New Bedford

Wednesday November 1st 1865. fresh wind from the
 S. E. steering S. W. by S. under whole top sails
 at 2 Pm raised. Whales about to the ship. The 1st
 whale hauled in the Capt's Boat and struck a
 small whale. Mr. Thosom also struck and sounded
 and took his line. We took the whale along side at
 4 Pm and had him all on deck at 6 Pm. at 8 Pm
 we started the work. weather quite favorable

 out at 6 Pm finished boiling on the weather
 were favorable. nothing in sight during the day
 Lat 22.09 Long 31.00 about

Friday Nov 3rd Moderate wind from South and
 East-Ward. continue steering about S. W. under all
 sail ship come at the rate of 5 to 6 knots emp-
 loyed moderately one vessel in sight during the day
 at 11. steering to the North-Ward nothing else
 in sight during the day

Saturday Nov 4th Moderate wind continue from
 the S. E. steering about S. W. under all sail. wea-
 ther were pleasant at Pm a shoal of Peppercorn came
 about to the ship. struck two sawed one. at 11
 took in the light sails. weather squally. employed in
 breaking out water Lat 24.21

Sunday Nov 5th unfavorable wind continue
 from the North-Ward steering about N. S. W. at Pm
 set all sail, ship not making much head way.
 at 1 Pm the wind hauled to the S. W. backed and
 steered S. E. weather pleasant. at 4 Pm saw two killers
 about to the ship going quite quick.

Monday Nov 6th light wind from the N. E. W.
 steering South. under all sail. ship going at the
 rate of 4 knots weather squally but quite pleasant
 employed variously. one ship in sight steering about
 S. E. Lat 21.20 Tuesday Nov 7th fresh wind from
 the N. W. steering S. E. by S. under all sail. ship going
 at the rate of 8 knots weather pleasant. employed various-
 ly nothing in sight during the day. at 11 broke out
 the Stow Cask. and emptied it except a few things
 such as Rats and Bones &c.
