

Remarks On Board Sunday April 24th 1831
Commenced with light breezes and variable with
pleasant weather till 10th got under way with a light
breeze of the wind shifted to the west
Middle Part fresh breeze from the Eastward steering
to the S.W. & Latter part made the same
Employed in handling the cables and observing the
Anchor Lat 11° 12' South Long by Chronometer 44° 21' East

Remarks On Monday April 25th
Commenced with fresh breeze from the S.W.
Steering by the wind to the N.E. & S.W.
Middle Part moderate breeze from the S.East
and pleasant weather Steering by the wind to the
S.W. Latter Part made the same Lat 11° 30' South

Remarks On Tuesday April 26th
Commenced with light breeze from the S.W.
and pleasant all sail out steering by the wind
to the Eastward Middle Part made the same
Latter part light breeze with fine pleasant
weather all sail set by the wind heading
to the S.W. & wind from the S.East
Lat 11° 33' South Long by Chronometer 46° 40' East

Remarks On Wednesday April 27th
Commenced with light breeze from the S.W.
Steering by the wind to the Eastward
Middle Part made the same
Latter part moderate breeze from the
S.W. with fine pleasant weather
all sail out steering by the wind to the Eastward
Lat 11° 34' South

Remarks On Thursday April 28th
Commenced with light breeze from the S.East
Steering by the wind to the S.W. all sail set
Saw great number of porpoises and Blackfish
Middle Part made the same
Latter part strong breeze from S.East
attended with squalls of Rain at 4th M took in
the top gallant sail at 10 Double reefed the
top sails Lat 11° 34' 9" South

Remarks On Friday April 29th
Commenced with fresh gale from the S.East
Steering by the wind to the S.W. at 4 P.M.
at 1 P.M. were ship to the S.W. at 4 P.M.
Let every reef out the main top sail and set the top gall
Middle part moderate from the S.W. steering
by the wind to the S.W. Latter part made the same
Lat 11° 35' 28" South Long 48° 57' E

Remarks On Board Saturday April 30th
Commenced with fresh breeze from the S.W. & E
Steering by the wind to the S.W. at 4 P.M.
took in the main top gallant sail and
red in the fore and mizen top sails
Middle part made the same
Latter part attended with squalls of Rain
at noon saw a shoal of sperm whales going quick
to the S.W. lowered all the Boats Chased could not
fasten Lat 11° 35' 44" South

Remarks On Sunday May 1st 1831
Commenced with light breezes from the Eastward
attended with squalls of Rain at 3 P.M. took in the
main top sail Middle part light breeze from the S.W. steering
by the wind to the S.W. Latter part light breeze from the S.W.
Steering by the wind to the S.W. at 4th M saw a shoal of
whales to the S.W. & kept of for them till Lat 11° 42' S

Remarks On Monday May 2nd
Commenced with light breezes from the S.East
at 1 P.M. lowered the Boats at 2 P.M. took in
the main top sail & took in a long sail
Middle part fresh breeze from the S.W. steering by the
wind to the Eastward at 4th M saw a shoal of whales to the
S.W. & kept of for them till Lat 11° 48' S
at 3 P.M. began to back to East
Lat 11° 35' 10" South

Remarks On Tuesday May 3rd 1831
Commenced with moderate breeze from the S.East
Steering by the wind to the S.East Employed in hauling
Middle part attended with squalls of Rain
at 3 P.M. took in the top gallant sail

at 4th M took in the S.W. at 10 got the main top sail
Lat 11° 35' 10" 20" South Long by Chronometer 48° 50' E

the fore and mizen top gallant sails
Middle part attended with squalls of Rain
Latter part light breeze and fair weather Employed in
hauling and steaming the S.W. between Decks
at 3 P.M. took in the S.W. wind from the S.W.
Lat 11° 35' 10" 30" South Long by Chronometer 48° 50' E

Remarks On Board Friday May 6th

by the wind to the S.W. at 3 P.M. took in the Eastward
unbent the fore and bent the Spanker and bent a new
main top sail Middle part moderate breeze from
the South with fair weather
Latter part made the same all sail set in the
wind Lat 11° 35' 34" South

Commenced with fresh breeze from the S.W. & E
Steering by the wind to the S.W. at 3 P.M.
Employed in repairing the main top sail
at 6 P.M. took in the top sail
Middle part fresh breeze and squalls
Latter part made the same steering by the wind to the S.W.
Lat 11° 35' 40" South

by the wind to the S.W. at 3 P.M. took in the main top sail
and Spanker Middle part made the same
Latter part fresh breeze from the S.W. steering by the

Lat 11° 35' 40" South Long by Chronometer 48° 50' E

Latter part more moderate set the main top sail and
Spanker and let every reef out the main top sail at 10
Lat 11° 35' 40" South
