at 11 Commencing Bailing the Bunt
Lat 1° 35' 22" South Long by Chronometer 46" 54 East

staying by the wind to the S.W.
Middle part much the same
Latter part light breeze from the S.W.
with fair pleasant weather staying by the wind
to the S.W. Employed Bailing
at 11 at 11 took to the westward
Lat 1° 35' 22" South

at midnight set the reef out the top sails
Latter part much the same at 9 P.M. set the top
sails at 10 P.M. at 10 P.M. 10" 22 South
Long by Chronometer 45" 25 East

Remarks On Board Sunday May 22nd
Commenced with light breeze from the S.W.
staying by the wind to the S.W.
Middle part the same
Latter part moderate breeze from the South staying by the
wind to the S.W. at 6 P.M. saw the Land Baring N.W.
and Lard Baring S.W. at 7 P.M. began to stow
Down the Bunt Lat 1° 35' 11" 07 South

Remarks On Board Monday May 23rd
Commenced with light breeze from the S.W.
staying by the wind to the S.W. at 8 P.M. finished stowing
Down the Middle part fresh breeze
and fair weather staying by the wind to the S.W. Latter part
the same Lat 1° 35' 12" 40 South

Remarks On Board Tuesday May 24th
Commenced with light breeze from the S.W.
and pleasant weather staying by the wind to the S.W.
at 6 P.M. took to the S.W. East
Middle part fair weather at 11 P.M. took to the S.W.
Latter part light breeze from the S.W. staying by the wind
to the westward at 8 P.M. saw the Land Baring S.W. to N.W.
at 9 P.M. took to the S.W. Lat 1° 35' 13" 54 South
Long by Chronometer 40" 35 East

Remarks On Board Wednesday May 25th
Commenced with light breeze from the S.W. at 1 P.M.
took to the S.W. the water supply with Bailing the
Main Sail at 7 P.M. took to the eastward
Middle part fair weather from the S.W. at midnight took
to the S.W. at 8 P.M. took to the eastward at noon took
to the S.W. Lat 1° 35' 14" 30 South
Long by Chronometer 41" 15 East

weather staying by the wind to the S.W. at 1 P.M.
at 2 P.M. took to the S.W. the Land is sight Baring N.W.
to S.W. at 3 P.M. took to the S.W. Middle part fair weather
at 4 P.M. took to the S.W.
Latter part fresh breeze from the South at 5 P.M. took
the top gallant sail at 6 double reefed the fore and mizzen
sails Lat 1° 35' 15" 16 South

Remarks On Board Friday May 27th
Commenced with moderate breeze and fair weather
at 1 P.M. set the reef out the top sails at 4 saw the Land
Baring N.W. at 6 P.M. took to the S.W.
Middle part pleasant breeze and fair weather
at 8 P.M. took to the S.W.
Latter part light breeze and fair weather at 4 P.M. saw
the Land Baring S.W. to N.W. at 5 P.M. took to the S.W.
at 6 P.M. Lat 1° 35' 15" 45 South

Remarks On Board Saturday May 28th
Commenced with moderate breeze from the South
staying by the wind to the S.W.
Middle part much the same at 3 P.M. took
to the westward
Latter part moderate breeze with pleasant weather
Lat 1° 35' 16" 26 South
Long by Chronometer 40" 26 East
