

Remarks On Board Monday May 30th 1831

Commenced with light breeze from the South
Stearing by the wind to the WSW with all sail
out at 2 P.M. took to the ESE at 7 were ship
to the WSW Middle Part light breeze from the
SE steering by the wind to the WSW
Employed in getting the crew boats to order
at 11 P.M. 11 S Long by Chronometer 55° 42' E

Remarks On Tuesday May 31st

Commenced with a calm and pleasant weather
Middle Part light breeze from the SE
Stearing to the SE
Latter Part moderate breeze from the SE
with fine pleasant weather Steering by
the wind to the SE with all sail out
at 11 P.M. 13° 03' South

Remarks On Wednesday June 1st

Commenced with pleasant breeze from the
SE and pleasant weather Steering by the wind
to the SE Middle Part light breeze from the South
Latter Part light breeze from the South
with fine pleasant weather
Stearing by the wind to the SE
at 11 P.M. 20° 40' S Long 55° 16' East

Remarks On Board Thursday June 2nd

Commenced with light breeze from the SE
Stearing by the wind to the SE all sail set
to advantage Middle Part pleasant breeze
from the SE steering by the wind
Latter Part moderate breeze from the South
at 11 P.M. 21° 31' South

Remarks On Friday June 3rd

Commenced with light breeze from the SE
and pleasant weather Steering by the wind
to the SE at 2 P.M. saw a ship to the
windward Steering to the SE
Middle Part pleasant weather
Latter Part moderate breeze from the SE
at 5 A.M. saw
Spoke of Whales, killed 5 of them
at noon got 3 of them a long side to order
at 11 P.M. 22° 43' South Long 56° 53' East

Remarks On Saturday June 4th

Commenced with light breeze from the South
at 7 A.M. got the other Whales a long side at 2
Commenced toiling at 7 finished
Middle Part pleasant weather Employed
following away the heads at 2 P.M. commenced
boiling Latter part moderate breeze at 7 at 11 took
to the SE at 11 P.M. 23° 01' South 57° 16' East

Remarks On Board Sunday June 5th

Commenced with moderate breeze from the
SE Steering by the wind to the SE
at 6 P.M. took in the fore and mizen top sails
Middle Part moderate breeze from the South
Stearing to the SE
Latter part pleasant weather at 7 at 11 were
ship to the SE and set the top sails
Employed in hauling the heads
at 11 P.M. 25° 50' South

Remarks On Monday June 6th

Commenced with light breeze from the SE
Stearing by the wind to the SE
at 8 P.M. finished boiling Middle Part
Latter Part light breeze from the SE
at 11 P.M. 24° 07' South

Remarks On Tuesday June 7th

Commenced with light breeze from the SE
with fine pleasant weather Steering to the SE
Middle Part strong breeze from the South
Stearing to the SE at 3 at 4 P.M. took in the top gallant
Latter Part strong gale with flying clouds
at 11 the gale abated and hauled to seaward
the watch Employed in sending down the fore
and mizen Royal mast to order
at 11 P.M. 25° 08' South Long by chronometer 55° 20' East

Remarks On Board Wednesday June 8th 1831

Commenced with moderate breeze attended with
squalls of rain at noon saw a school of whales
headed East at 2 P.M. saw a ship in Board
took in the fore and mizen top sails
Middle Part light breeze attended with a heavy
transport at 5 at 11 were ship to the South
Latter part strong gale from the South at 4 at 11
the fore sail broke with heavy squalls
at 11 P.M. 25° 16' South

Remarks On Thursday June 9th

Commenced with strong gale from the South
Stearing to the SE at 11 P.M. saw a ship in Board
the fore sail broke at 4 P.M. finished waving ship
to the SE and set the mizen top sail
Middle Part moderate breeze
Latter Part moderate breeze at 7 P.M. were ship
to the SE at 11 P.M. 25° 28' South by Chronometer
55° 30' East

Remarks On Friday June 10th

Commenced with strong gale from the SE
Stearing to the SE at 1 P.M. set the fore top sail
Middle Part the gale increased at 1 at 11 took in
the fore and mizen top sails at 2 took in the fore sail
Latter part the gale abated at 7 at 11 were ship to the
SE at 3 were again to SE and set the fore sail
at noon saw a school of Whales to order
at 11 P.M. 25° 33' South

Remarks On Board Saturday June 11th

Commenced with strong gale from the SE
Stearing to the SE under close reef main top sail
and reef fore sail
Middle Part moderate breeze at midnight
were ship to the SE Latter part moderate
gale at 2 at 11 set the fore and mizen top sail
at 8 set one reef out the top sails and fore sail
and set the mizen sail at 11 spoke the ship
Tobacco plant of eye Redhead 170 barrels of spirits
at 11 P.M. 25° 49' South

Remarks On Sunday June 12th

Commenced with strong breeze from the SE
Stearing to the SE at 5 P.M. close reef the
fore and mizen top sails and took in the fore
Middle Part strong gale and pleasant weather
Latter Part strong gale and pleasant weather
at 11 P.M. saw a ship to the SE at 11
took in the fore and mizen top sails at 11 set them
at 11 P.M. 25° 52' South

Remarks On Monday June 13th

Commenced with moderate breeze from the SE
and squalls Steering to the SE
Middle Part moderate breeze from the SE
Latter part attended with squalls of rain
Stearing to the SE at 11 P.M. 24° 46' South

Remarks On Board Tuesday June 14th

Commenced with moderate breeze from the SE
Stearing to the SE in company with the Tobacco plant
Middle part moderate breeze from the SE
Latter part light breeze with fine pleasant weather
at 6 A.M. commenced broaching out the fore
at 7 saw whale struck and killed one of them at 11 took
him a long side at 11 commenced toiling to order
at 11 P.M. 24° 01' South

Remarks On Wednesday June 15th

Commenced with light wind from the SE
and pleasant weather at 2 P.M. saw a school of
a school of whales at 4 took her alongside commenced toiling
at 5 finished Middle Part pleasant weather to the SE
at 6 P.M. commenced toiling
Latter part light breeze from the South Steering by the
wind to the SE at 11 took to the SE
at 11 P.M. 24° 04' S Long by Chronometer 55° 27' East

Remarks On Thursday June 16th

Commenced with light breeze from the SE
Stearing by the wind to the SE Middle part light breeze from
the South Steering to the SE Latter part pleasant
at 8 at 11 commenced waving down to order
at 11 P.M. 23° 04' South
