

Remarks On Board Tuesday July 5th 1831
Commenced with light breeze from the South
with fine pleasant weather saw nothing
Middle part fine weather
Latter part fair weather Boats a whale
saw no whales to Ende this Day

Remarks On Wednesday July 6th
Commenced with light breeze from the
South and fair weather saw nothing
Middle part pleasant weather at 3 P.M. heard
a whale about 10 miles off
Latter part fair weather at 6 P.M. heard the
Boats at 9 P.M. saw one whale about 10 miles
further to Ende this Day

Remarks On Thursday July 7th
Commenced with light breeze from the
South with fine pleasant weather saw two
whales about 10 miles off at 1 P.M. came up
one of them the Boat stayed near her
at 2 P.M. came on Board
Middle part fine weather
Latter part much the same at 6 P.M. heard
again saw nothing worth noting to Ende

Remarks On Friday July 8th
Commenced with light breeze from the South
with fine pleasant weather the Boats at last
saw nothing Middle part fair weather
Latter part much the same to Ende this Day

Remarks On Saturday July 9th
Commenced with fresh breeze from the
South and fair weather at 1 P.M. the Boats
came on Board Middle part the same
Latter part squally at 7 P.M. saw one
whale about 10 miles off at noon came
on Board again to Ende this Day

Remarks On Sunday July 10th
Commenced with fresh breeze from the
SSE and cloudy sky with squalls
Middle part fair weather
Latter part squally breeze from the
South and squally to Ende this Day

Remarks On Monday July 11th
Commenced with light breeze from the South
and fair weather Middle part the same
Latter part squally all the Boats of
saw nothing to Ende

Remarks On Tuesday July 12th
Commenced with light breeze from the South
with fine pleasant weather the Boats at 10
whaling saw nothing worth noting
Latter part attended with squalls of rain
not one Boat ashore after noon to Ende

Remarks On Wednesday July 13th
Commenced with light breeze from the
South and fine pleasant weather employed
getting of wood Middle part fair weather
Latter part much the same to Ende

Remarks On Thursday July 14th
Commenced with moderate breeze from
the SE with fair weather two Boats on shore
after noon the other after rain
Middle part fine weather Latter part much
the same employed in shops at 10 P.M. to Ende

Remarks On Friday July 15th
Commenced with light breeze and calm
Middle part much the same
Latter part light breeze from the South at 10 P.M.
got under way and returned to the SE at 11
then came to anchor again in the morning at water

Remarks On Board Saturday July 16th
Commenced with calm pleasant weather employed
getting up the main top gallant mast and yard
Middle part fine pleasant weather
Latter part much the same at 8 P.M. got under
way in company with the Loss vessel
at 11 saw one right whale about 10 miles off

Remarks On Sunday July 17th
Commenced with light air and calm at 1 P.M.
saw two hump Backed porpoises about 10 miles
off them and drove the Loss at 3 P.M. came
on Board again at 4 came at anchor in 9 fathoms
at East part of Barents Baying at 7 P.M. from
compass East S. by S. middle part light breeze
from the SE with fine pleasant weather
Latter part much the same at 7 P.M. got under way again
and steered to the SE S. Ende Lat 23° 21' 10" South

Remarks On Monday July 18th
Commenced with moderate breeze from the
SE at 1 P.M. and fine weather Middle part pleasant
Latter part much the same
at 6 P.M. employed repairing the
fore top yard to Ende
Lat 23° 28' 15" South

Remarks On Tuesday July 19th
Commenced with moderate breeze from
the SE at 1 P.M. steering to the SE East at 6 P.M.
brought to the wind to the Eastward
Middle part fine pleasant weather
at 8 P.M. were ship to the SE at 10 P.M. to Ende
Lat 23° 28' 22" South Long by Chronometer 37° 30' 20"

Remarks On Wednesday July 20th
Commenced with light breeze from the
SE at 1 P.M. steering by the wind to the SE at 7 P.M.
Middle part much the same at midnight
were ship to the Eastward
Latter part light breeze from the South
to the SE at 10 P.M. to Ende Lat 23° 41' South

Remarks On Thursday July 21st
Commenced with light breeze from the South
with fine pleasant weather steering at 1 P.M.
Middle part light breeze and variable
Latter part light breeze from the SE at 10 P.M.
steering by the wind to the SE at 10 P.M. to Ende
Lat 23° 42' South Long by Chronometer 36° 28'

Remarks On Friday July 22nd
Commenced with light breeze from the SE
steering by the wind to the SE at 2 P.M.
tacked to the SE
Middle part fine pleasant weather
Latter part much the same steering
by the wind to the Eastward wind from the SE at
Lat 23° 15' South

Remarks On Saturday July 23rd
Commenced with fresh breeze from SE and fair weather
steering by the wind to the Eastward at 4 P.M. tacked
to the SE and Douglas reefed the top sails
Middle part much the same
Latter part fresh gale at 8 P.M. took in the fore top sail
and close reefed the other topsails to Ende this Day
Lat 23° 24' South

Remarks On Monday July 24th
Commenced with moderate breeze from
the SE steering by the wind to the Eastward
Middle part much the same
Latter part light breeze and fair weather
at 8 P.M. tacked to the SE at 10 P.M. to Ende
Lat 23° 25' South
