commenced with all hands Employed in Ship's Duty & hauling Oil and
Ship insight to the windward & middle part fresh breezes from the
South & C. at 8 Am Saw whales forced 3 boats Starboard
boats fastened at 10 Am took the whale a long Side and commenced
cutting at half past 11 Am Saw another whale close to the
Ship forced away the Starboard boats & fastened and sounds these
24 hours Lat in by Chb 33.08 South & Long in 07.30 East & C.

Tuesday December the 3th Day

the first part of these 24 hours commenced with pleasant weath-
er & the Starboard & Starboard boats off whale in at 3 Am
took the whale a long Side & commenced cutting at 7 Am finish
ed & set the watch & commenced hauling and middle part pleas-
