These 24 hours strong breezes from the westward headed N.W. at 3 P.M. made the land bearing S.S. 88° 45' miles distance at 6 P.M. sounded 150 fathoms no bottom at 1/2 6 P.M. wore ship headed S. by W. at 7 P.M. top gallant sails middle part moderate wether heavy swell setting to the south at 6 wore ship to the north latter part the wind baffling wore ship headed S. W. by S So Ends

Saturday Feb the 22. 1838

This day begins with strong breezes and squally wether headed S.W. by S. by the wind at 4 P.M. raised a school of sperm whales at 6 come up with them lowered and struck one to the waist boat he ran two lines and part of the third it being dark we cut and went on board at 8 P.M. tacked ship and headed S.W. 88° by the wind middle part the wether more moderate latter part headed S.W. by W. as a course So Ends

Sunday Feb the 23. 1838

These 24 hours commences with thick cloudy wether wind from the southward headed S.W. by W. as a course with all sail set watches employed in ships duty middle part the wind headed out S.E. latter part clear and pleasant So Ends

Monday Feb the 24. 1838

These 24 hours commences with fine and pleasant breezes from the S.E. headed S.W. 88° by W. as a course at 4 P.M. steered S.W. 88° middle part continues fine and pleasant at 6 P.M. steered S.W. 88° by S. latter part thick and foggy So Ends these 24 hours

Tuesday Feb the 25. 1838

These 24 hours commences with fine and pleasant breezes from the S.E. course S.W. 88° by W. at 4 P.M. made the cape layallies at 7 P.M. steered S.W. 88° at 7 P.M. steered S.W. 88° at 10 P.M. cape of good hope bore east 70 miles distance latter part paid a brig and a ship steering to the eastward So Ends these 24 hours

Wednesday Feb the 26. 1838

These 24 hours commences with strong breezes and rugged wether wind S.E. course S.W. 88° middle part continues much the same latter part watches employed in bundling bone So Ends the 24 hours
