

April the 12. 1838

These 24 hours commences with fresh gales
from S.E. steering N.W. as a course
Middle and latter part Rainy so ends
Lat 25.50 North
Long 55.10 West

April the 13. 1838

These 24 hours commences with strong gales
from the S.E. course N.W. at 4 P.M.
Commenced squally and rainy Middle
part Clear latter part watches fitting
for painting so ends Lat 25.19 North
Long 55.10 West

April the 14. 1838

These 24 hours commences with fine and
pleasant wind from S.E. course N.W.
latter part all hands employed in
painting so ends Lat 26.00 North
Long 58.00 West

April the 15. 1838

These 24 hours commences with light
breezes from S.E. steered N.W. as a course
with all sail set to the best advantage
latter cloudy so ends Lat 26.40 North
Long 58.55 West

April the 16. 1838

This day commences with light winds and
calm latter part Rainy so ends this day
Lat 27.35 North
Long 60.00 West

April the 17. 1838

These 24 hours commences with light breezes from
N.E. course N.W. by N. Middle and latter part
continues much the same so ends this day
Lat 28.00 North
Long 61.10 West

April the 18. 1838

These 24 hours commences with light breeze
from N.E. course N.W. Middle and latter
weather continues much the same so ends
Lat 29.39 North
Long 63.18 West

April the 19. 1838

These 24 hours commences with thick weather
and light breezes from the N.E. course N.W.
Middle part strong breeze latter part strong
strong so ends these 24 hours Lat 30.00 North
Long 64.50 West

April the 20. 1838

These 24 hours commences with strong breeze
from S.E. course steered N.W. by the
wind middle part blows more fresh latter
fine and pleasant so ends Lat 33.30 North
Long 67.00 West

April the 21. 1838

These 24 hours commences with heavy gale
from the N.W. headed to the S.E. on the
wind Middle and latter part the wind
buffeting so ends this day Lat 35.40 North
Long 67.40 West
