

Wednesday. April. 22nd. 1840.

This day commences with a light breeze from S^W the ship heading N^W & by the wind middle and latter part the same

Thursday. April. 23rd.

This day commences with a light breeze from the Eastward at 12 o'clock tacked ship and stood to Southward. at 4. P.M. tacked again and stood to the Northward

Friday. April. 24th.

This day commences with strong breezes and ends with the same.

Saturday. April. 25th.

This day commences with a strong breeze from S^W & N^W. heading along on the wind middle and latter parts moderates

Sunday. April. 26th.

This day commences with a light breeze from S^W & N^W. middle and latter parts light breeze with rain.

Monday. April. 27th.

This day commences with a light breeze and continues thus through the day with rain
Saw hump backs

Tuesday. April. 28th. 1840.

This day commences with a light breeze and continues thus through the day

Wednesday. April. 29th.

This day commences with a light breeze from the Eastward bobbing along on the wind

Thursday. April. 30th.

This day commences with a light breeze and continues the same throughout the day
all hands employed in bending sails &c.

Friday. May 1st.

Commences with a calm middle and latter parts light airs

Saturday May 2nd.

Commences with light winds from S^W course E by S. middle and latter parts fresh breezes and dull times.

Sunday May 3rd.

Commences with strong breezes middle and latter parts the same

Monday. May 4th.

Commences with a strong gale from W. lying to under short sail middle part more moderate at 6. P.M. saw a shoal of sperm whales & lowered the boats the waist boat got fast and got stove thus ends the day with no whales
