

Wednesday August 12th 1840.

Commences with strong gales and continues thus through the day.

Thursday 13th

commences with strong breezes middle & latter part moderate

Friday 14th

Commences with strong breezes latter part moderates

Saturday 15th Long 114.00 ft

Commences with light winds & ends with the same

Sunday 16th

Light winds middle & latter parts calm

Monday 17th

Calm middle & latter parts strong breezes & rain

Tuesday 18th

Strong breezes and continues thus through the day

Wednesday 19th

Strong breezes & ends with light winds

Thursday 20th

Light winds & ends with strong gales

Friday 21st

Strong gales latter part light winds course #8th Long 110.36 ft

Saturday 22nd

Strong and continues thus through the day.

Sunday 23rd

Strong breezes middle & latter parts the same

Monday 24th

commences with strong breezes course #1. At 6 PM double reefed the topsails & luffed to the wind at sunrise made the land. At 4 AM sent the boat ashore for the pilot in a rain storm.

Tuesday 25th

commences with light winds & squally at sun down the boat came on board with a pilot stood off and on to land during the night. at daylight stood in for the harbour ends with light winds

Wednesday August 26th 1840

Commences with light winds standing in for the harbour. At 10 AM came to anchor 4 miles from the city.

Thursday 27th

Light winds At 1 PM got underway & beat into the harbour. at 4 PM came to anchor sent a boat ashore

Friday 28th

Light winds sent down the topgallant yards & hoisted the topgallant masts & sent a raft ashore

Saturday 29th

commences with light winds all hands employed in doing up a few port jobs

Sunday 30th

Commences with light winds and ends the same

Monday 31st

commences with light winds employed in various jobs

Tuesday 1st

light winds one boat wooding middle & latter part strong breezes & squally

Wednesday 2nd

Strong breezes & squally the watch on liberty

Thursday 3rd

Strong winds & squally one watch on liberty

Friday 4th

Light winds through the day one watch on liberty

Saturday 5th

Light winds all day two boats ashore after water

Sunday 6th

Light winds middle & latter parts squally

Monday 7th

commences with light winds & ends with the same one watch on liberty 2 hands deserted

Tuesday 8th

Light winds at sunrise weighed anchor & beating out shipped two hands
