first & middle light wind latter part calm

Thursday 19th

Light airs gaming with two Brothers middle & latter the same

Friday 20th

Light airs two Brothers in sight middle & latter fresh gales

Saturday 21st

first fresh gales middle & latter parts light winds

Sunday 22nd

Commences with light breeze & ends with the same

Monday 23rd

Light winds through the ^{day} all hands employed doing nothing

Tuesday Nov. 24th 1840.

Light winds from ^{to by S} middle & latter part strong breeze

Wednesday 25th

Pleasant gales from ^{to by S} course NW. At 9 AM. saw sperm whale
lowered the boats got fast to the ^{as} B. whale took the line & cut stick

Thursday 26th

Light airs middle the same. at 8 AM had a heavy squall
from NW. took in sail & hove too heading ^{to} W-sea

Friday 27th

first strong gales middle & latter parts moderating made sail

Saturday 28th

Light winds from ^{to by S} middle & latter parts the same

Sunday 29th

Light winds & squally. saw a ship steering to the Eastward

Monday 30th

first strong breezes middle & latter parts light winds &c.

Tuesday Dec ^{ber} 1st 1840.

Light winds through the day saw plenty of finbacks

Wednesday 2nd

Light winds from NW bound to the westward. At 5 P.M. saw
a right whale lowered 2 boats but without success At 9 P.M. saw
a ship steering to the Eastward middle & latter strong breeze

Thursday 3rd

Pleasant gale & rainy middle & latter parts the same

Friday 4th

Strong gales from NW middle & latter parts the same

Saturday 5th

Strong breeze from NW middle & latter part the same

Sunday 6th

Strong breezes & rainy middle part light winds. at day light
saw two ships. One hoisting oil the other steering ^{to}

Monday 7th

Strong breeze from NW steering of one ship in sight

Tuesday 8th

Pleasant gales saw a ship middle & latter parts more
moderate made sail
