First part calm middle & latter part a breeze from NW Long 99 00 E

Monday 22nd

Strong breeze through the day from S by E steering S by E.

Tuesday 23rd

Came with strong wind ends the same at sundown took in sail

Wednesday 24th

Came with strong breeze from S. middle & latter the same

Thursday 25th

Strong breeze through the day watches employed in sailing ship

Friday 26th

Light winds through the day the day ends as usual

Saturday 27th

Came with strong breeze from S & ends the same dull times

Sunday 28th

Came with light winds from S E. At 6 AM saw a shoal of sperm whales it being rather late got none Lat 30 30 S

Monday March 1st 1841.

Long 105 25 E

Came with strong breeze from S E. towards noon increasing to a gale took in sail brought too under close reefed M D

Tuesday 2nd

Long 106 20 E

Light breeze through the day from S W. course S by S. At 6 AM gale subsiding made sail at 11 spoke ship Hercules of New Bedford 130 bbls sperm saw the Barclay Lat 29 40 S

Wednesday 3rd

Long 108 16 E

Came with strong breeze ends with the same

Thursday 4th

Strong breeze through the day in want of oil.

Friday 5th

Strong breeze through the day. bobbing along by the wind

Saturday 6th

Came with strong winds with light breezes

Lat 28 30 S

Sunday 7th

Long 108 25 E

Came with light breeze ends with fresh breezes

Lat 28 19 S

Monday 8th

Long 108 44 E

Came with strong breeze ends the same

Lat 27 34 S

Long 108 16 E

Tuesday March 9th 1841 —

Commences with light breeze all hands employed in mending sail

Wednesday 10th

Light breeze through the day at 1 PM raised at 1 PM whale down boats fastened & took him along side to the W.B. At 4 PM spoke barque Strath of Fairhaven Capt

Lat 28 34 S

Long 108 34 E

Thursday 11th

Light winds through the day at daylight commenced cutting at 1 PM finished at 2 began to boil

Friday 12th

Came with light winds all hands employed in boiling

Saturday 13th

Light breeze through the day at 4 PM finished boiling the 25.45

Sunday 14th

Long 108 10 E

Came with light breeze and continues thus through the day at 1 PM

Monday 15th

Strong breeze all day at daylight commenced stowing down at 6 PM finished thus ends of hard days work Lat 28 29

Tuesday 16th

Came with light breeze middle & latter part strong breeze Lat 28 29 S

Wednesday 17th

Long 108 14 E

Came with strong breeze at 5 PM took in fore & mizzen top sail at sunset the wind increasing to a gale from 17 E took in fore sail

Thursday 18th

Long 109 25 E

Came with a gale of wind from S E lying too under reefed sail Lat 29 00 S

Friday 19th

Came with a gale from the old quarter this end

Saturday 20th

Came with a strong breeze from S E Lat 28 30 S

Sunday 21st

Long 106 30 E

Came with a strong breeze & ends with the same at 4 PM caught by surprise Lat 27 00 S

Monday 22nd

Long 107 34 E

Came with a strong breeze & ends with the same Lat 28 22 S

Tuesday 23rd

Long 108 20 E

Came with strong breeze continues thus through the day Lat 28 30 S

Long 108 00 E
