Thursday 24th 1 Calm with light breeze & ends likewise at 8 am set the foretopmast studding sail. At 9 am one of the pumps being somewhat out of repairs hoisted it out stopped the leak & replaced it again. Sat. 21.41.5

Friday 25th 1 Light breeze from NE by E. course W by S. Long. 69.52.7

Saturday 26th 1 First part light breeze from E. course W by S. one sail in sight. latter part cloudy & rainy thus ends

Sunday 27th 1 Strong breeze from NW by E. course W. Sat. 20.07.5

Monday 28th 1 Light breeze from E by E. course W by S. Long. 83.13.7

Tuesday 29th 1 Strong breeze & squally course W by S. Sat. 19.58.5

Wednesday 30th 1 Light breeze from E by S. course W by S. Long. 18.41.7

Thursday July 1st 1 Pleasant breeze through the day course W by S. Sat. 19.26.5

Friday 2nd 1 Calm with light breeze from E by E. course W by S. Long. 14.18.5

At 4 am saw a ship standing. W by S. Sat. 19.30.5 Long. 71.30.7

Saturday 3rd 1 Light breeze from E by E. course W by S. All hands employed in cleaning ship. latter part calm

Sunday 4th 1 Calm through the day Sat. 19.46.8 Long. 40.02.7

Monday 5th 1 Light through the day from E by E. course W by S. All hands breaking out for provisions.

Tuesday 6th 1 Strong breeze latter rainy Sat. 19.46.8 Long. 66.13.7

Wednesday 7th 1 Calm with light breeze from E by E. course W by S. At 8 am made Rodrigue Sat. 19.46.8 Long. 63.24.7

Thursday 8th 1 Strong breeze from E by E. course W by S. At 6 am double reefed topsails at 11 am moderating made all sail at 1 pm saw a ship. Sat. 19.33.5 Long. 61.11.7

Friday 9th 1 Calm & ends with strong breeze & ends with the same at 9 am made the land at 3 pm took Pilot at 5 pm came to anchor at the Isle of France.

Wednesday 17th 1 Fine weather through the day at 1 pm weighed anchor & put to sea without going on shore. thus ends

Friday 19th 1 First light breeze latter part strong breeze

Saturday 20th 1 Cloudy & squally through the day Sat. 16.30.8

Sunday 21st 1 Strong breezes with squalls from E by E. Sat. 16.45.8

Monday 22nd 1 Fine breeze from westward steering S. Sat. 17.27.5

Tuesday 23rd 1 Strong breeze & squally through the day. Sat. 18.04.8

Wednesday 24th 1 Fine weather through the day Sat. 18.48

Thursday 25th 1 Light breeze from E by E. course S by E. At 6 pm saw a brig to windward. S. Sat. 20.28

Friday 26th 1 First & middle strong breeze from E by E. course S by E. latter part rainy Sat. 21.45.8

Saturday 27th 1 First & latter light breeze middle calm Sat. 22.28.8

Sunday 28th 1 Light breeze through the day. At 12 o'clock commenced a heavy tempest which lasted greater part of the day. At 3 pm took in the fore & mizen topsails & set

Bootscrew watches. no damage done during the tempest

Monday 29th 1 Strong breeze all day from E by E. steering S. Sat. 24.45.8

Tuesday 30th 1 Commences with strong breezes & continues the same through the day watches employed in middle

stitching a topsail & bending a new foretopmast stay sail

Wednesday 31st 1 Strong breeze through the day at daylight unbent the foretop sail & bent a new one remainder of the

day mending sails latter part of the day rugged

Thursday Sept. 1st 1841 Commences with strong breezes & ends with the same at 4 am raised a sperm

whale down boats & struck to the S. the whale sounding

took out 2 lines. came up. The Capt. went along side & lance

him twice but to no effect at 3 got capsized. whale went off victorious
