the day course. W. & S. employment: the ships, duty, etc. etc.

Sunday 26th. Strong breeze all day

Monday 27th. Strong breeze through
the day watches employed in ships duty

Tuesday 28th. Strong breeze through
the day. Various jobs doing to day

Wednesday 29th. First part light
breeze middle & latter much the same employed in ships duty

Thursday 30th. First part light breeze
middle & latter strong breeze employed in fitting rigging

Friday 31st. Strong breeze through the day

Saturday Jan 1st 1842 — Strong

as a course, looking for Sperm whales sharp

strong breezes. employed in ships duty. Lat. 31.19 S
Long. 33.36 W

Thursday 6th. Strong winds through
the day from the Eastward. Steering West as a course
at 2 P.M. raised Sperm whales lowered fastened
to the S.B. line parting lost the whale pulled up
got fast to another the whale rounding took the
line. came up. & after much trouble killed &
took him alongside. Waist boat got fast & running
into the S.B. was forced to cut lost her whale.
The S.B. struck killed whale & lay by him till
night coming on dark & stormy cut & came on
board. did not save her whale. Lat. 31.39 S

Friday 7th. Com: tends moderate
At daylight com: Cutting off 6 P.M. finished. com: boiling

Saturday 8th. Com: tends with
with light breeze watches employed in boiling
Long. 31.3 W

Sunday 9th. Light breeze through the
day. At 4 P.M. cooled down. Long. 29.30 to east

Monday 10th. First part light breeze
middle & latter much the same. 3 sails in sight.

Tuesday 11th. First part light breeze
middle & latter strong breeze employed in stowing down
Long. 27.00 W

Wednesday 12th. First part strong breeze
middle & latter parts much the same. 2 sails in sight
