middle and latter part fine weather set fore  
topmast and main top gallant standing sails

Wednesday the 17th

50 Fresh breezes from N E steering S by E  
& Breeze steering to the westward middle and  
latter part strong breezes from N E steering S by W  
break out for water Lat 26 47

July 1844

Thursday the 18th

Fresh breezes from N E steering S W nothing in  
sight middle and latter part fine breezes  
steering S W employed in ships duty  
Lat 24 07  
Long 24 00 W

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Friday the 19th

Fresh breezes from N E steering S S W  
bent the New Main sail content the  
fore spencer at 4 P M steering S W by S  
middle and latter part fine breezes and good  
weather employed in making spun yarn  
Lat 24 50

July 1844

Saturday the 20th

Fine breezes from N E steering ship S W by S  
middle and latter part the same as ends  
employed in ships duty  
Lat 20 06  
Long 24 45

Remained with fine breezes from N E steering  
S W by W saw black fish did not lower for  
them middle and latter part fine weather
