August 1844

Wednesday the 7th

40 Fine trades and good weather got out water
a taring ship. S by W middle and latter
part the same ship heading S S W saw
fin backs and a sail so ends

c August 1844

Thursday the 8th

Fresh trades S E ship heading S S W
employed in ships duty middle part equal
with rain took in flying jib and top gallant sail
latter part clear up made all sail so ends

Friday the 9th

Fresh trades ship heading S by W saw kilboes
middle and latter part fine weather employed
in ships duty saw fin backs

Lat 10° 48'

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Saturday the 10th

Light trades and fine weather saw white
water taring rigging middle and latter
part fine weather ship heading S S W

Lat 12° 28'

c August 1844

Sunday the 11th

Light trades and good weather
Ship heading S W by S saw fin backs

Lat 14° 44'
Long 30° 15'

c August 1844

Monday the 12th

Light winds and good weather
middle and latter part the same
employed in ships duty
