

Ship Hibernia at Sea

August 1844

Tuesday the 13th
Freck trades ship heading S W by S all hands
employed in breaking out looking for
clay and lime got out water saw a
sail steering S W by N middle and latter
part fresh trades ship heading S S W saw
a sail heading to the southward break out
the after hatch way for clay and lime but
without success - Lat 18° 02'
Long 82° 00'

August 1844

Wednesday the 14th

West trades ship heading I saw fin
backs middle and latter part fresh
trades ship heading S S E saw several
sail heading different ways so ends
Lat 20° 11'
Long 84° 20'

August 1844

Thursday the 15th 2 Clerks

Freck trades from E S E ship heading
S E by S employed in ships clats middle
and latter part fine trades ship heading
S E saw a sail and fin backs
Lat 21° 51'

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Friday the 16th

Light breezes from E S E ship heading
S E by S sent down the fore top gallant
yard and fitted it saw Saffron Bottoms
middle part calm latter part a light
breeze from E S E ship heading I employed
in fanning the masts so ends one sail
in sight Lat 22° 38'

August 1844

Saturday the 17th

Light airs from the Eastward ship
heading to the southward saw White water
middle and latter part light air from E S E
ship heading I saw 12 sail heading the same
employed in ships duty
Lat 23° 11'
Long 87° 30'

August 1844

Sunday the 18th

Light airs ship heading North
middle and latter part fresh breeze ship
heading S E 9 sail in sight
Lat 24° 27'
