c August 1844

Monday the 19th

8 x Fine breezes from N.E. by E steering S.E.
at 3 P.M. spoke Spit Champion
of Bedford 30 m. of Stern middle and
latter part fresh breezes steering S.E. wind
N.W. E. at 11 P.M. spoke the C. the Capt came
on board — Lat 28.00

c August

Tuesday the 20th

10 4 Fresh breezes from N.E. by E steering S.E.
in Company with the Champion middle
part wind freshened, took in topgallant sails
and flying jib. latter part strong wind from
N.E. & hoisted reefed the top sails and took
in the main sail got out water and
pitched the cutting blocks & sail in sight
Lat 37.50
Long 25.40

c August 1844

Wednesday the 21st

Strong winds from the Northward steering
S.E. by E middle part squally with rain
took in the jib at 4 P.M. made sail
latter part fresh breezes with some
rain nothing in sight

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Thursday the 22nd

Break breezes from N.W. by E steering S.E. by E
employed in letting for the Champion middle
part squally latter part fresh breezes set
the main topgallant sail and flying jib

c August 1844

Friday the 23rd

Fresh breezes and squally took in the
light sails saw the Champion middle and
latter part moderate with plenty of rain
latter part light winds and fine weather
set fore topmast standing sail wind steering
S.E. by E employed in staying the mast
Lat 30.50
Long 14.45

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Saturday the 24th

11 0 Light breezes from N.W. by E and fine weather
steering S.E. by E middle and latter part
weather saw a sail steering the same
employed in ship duty Lat 32.00
got out water
