August 1844

Sunday the 25th
Fine breeze and good weather steering
S E by S middle and latter part fresh
breeze from the Northward so ends
Lat 34° 12'
Long 100° 30'

August 1844

Monday the 26th

Fresh breezes and clouds with a little
rain steering S E at 4 P.M. S E middle
and latter part fine breeze breeze from
steering S E by E employed in ships
duties so ends
Lat 35° 36' S
Long 71 35 W

August 1844

Tuesday the 27th

Fine breeze from it and cloudy weather
steering S E middle and latter part
the same employed same jobs
Lat 35° 47'

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Wednesday the 28th
Light breeze from NW E ship S E nothing
in sight but plenty of birds middle and
latter part fine weather steering S E by S wind
employed in fitting for unloading
No observer

August 1844

Thursday the 29th

Light breeze from W steering S E by S
at 6 P.M. wind hauled to SE
saw a sail at 10 P.M. latter part
light wind with some rain in night
No observer

August 1844

Friday the 30th

Fresh breezes from S W steering S E
set up fore topmast back stays saw a
Barge steering S E by E middle and
latter part fresh breeze employed in necessary
work so ends
Lat 37° 39'
Long 41 20 East
