Saturday the 31st and last
Strong breezes from S ship heading E by S
at 6 P.M. wind S S E ship heading E
middle and latter part light wind
and fresh in places so ends Lat 33° 17'

September 1844

Sunday the 1st
Commences with fresh breezes from S. E
ship heading E by E middle and latter
part the same Lat 32° 08' S
Long 9° 00' E

September 1844

Monday the 2nd

Commences with fresh breezes blowing
and heavy ship heading from E by E
to S E middle and latter part the
same employed in ship's duty so ends
2 men furnished for fighting Lat 31° 00'
Halifax and Glasgow Long 11° 35'

September 1844

Tuesday the 3rd

Light breezes and falling broke out for
provisions at 6 P.M. hauled to the
westward at 8 P.M. hauled to S S E
latter part light breezes and fine weather
employed in ship's duty so ends
Lat 31° 09'
Long 11° 17'
