September 1844 1844

Wednesday the 4th

Light breezes from S.W. ship heading S.E. nothing in sight middle and latter part light breezes from S.W. ship heading S.E. employed in sundries

Lat 32° 00'
Long 72° 30'

September 1844

Thursday the 5th

Light winds and hailing at 8 P.M. the ship heading N.W. middle part fresh breezes from S.E. ship heading S.W. latter part strong breeze from the same quarter employed in ship's duty so ends to be in the forenoon sail

Lat 33° 27'

September 1844

Friday the 6th

Strong breezes from S.E. ship heading S.W. middle part S.W. and S by W latter part light breezes employed in several gales all sail set

Lat 35° 40'

September 1844

Saturday the 7th

Commenced with light breezes from S.E. and steady ship heading S.W. at 2 P.M. calm sea let up the courses at 10 P.M. a light breeze from N.W. steering S.E. latter part strong breezes took in fore and main by galle sails went over the fore sail and fore top sail and got out water so ends

September 1844

Sunday the 8th

Strong breezes from N.W. ship steering E by S at 10 P.M. the foremast sail and fore top mast shedding sail at 2 P.M. wind hauled to S.W. and made a lee sail the part light winds from S.W. steering E by S

Lat 35° 14'
Long 76° 58'

September 1844

Monday the 9th

Light winds and hailing ship heading to the eastward at 6 P.M. wind E ship heading S by E middle part fine breeze latter part light winds ship heading S saw a sail steering N.W. employed in ship's duty so ends

Lat 36° 12'
