

Ship Hibernia at Sea W. J. Seimur

September 1844

Monday the 16th

Commences with fresh breeze from E by S ship heading S by E at 3 P.M. saw right whale toward the boat without success going quick came on board and took in sail for the night saw a sail to the windward gradually part right gale latter part good weather steering S by E employed in sundries so ends

September 1844

Tuesday the 17th

Light breeze and fine weather steering S by E at 6 P.M. took in sail for the night saw plenty of fin backs middle part calm at 6 P.M. made all sail steering to the Eastward nothing in sight

September 1844

Wednesday the 18th

Light breeze from S by W steering E by S saw fin backs repaired the old main sail and bent it stowed the new away at 6 P.M. took in sail for the night middle part good weather at 6 P.M. made all sail steering W by S saw an English Brig steering E latter part good weather employed in making a close miser out of the spanker

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September 1844

Thursday the 19th

Fresh breeze from the Southward steering N by E at 4 P.M. bent the close miser at 6 P.M. took in sail doubled reefed topsail and jib middle and latter part fresh breeze shifted the fore topsail so ends heading S by E

September 1844

Friday the 20th

Fresh breeze from E ship heading S by E employed in repairing a topsail at 5 P.M. finished middle part staying breeze and equally carrying sail toward to the Eastward heading S by E latter part fresh breeze from W by E ship heading S by E thick weather saw fin backs so ends

Lat 37. 21

September 1844

Saturday the 21st

Light breeze from N by E ship heading E by S saw a whale call it a Right whale but lost sight of him it being thick at 6 P.M. shortened sail for the night middle part calm at 6 P.M. made all sail a breeze from the Southward ship heading to the Eastward saw plenty of fin backs shifted the main topsail

this day got out water
