

Ship Hibernia at Sea N^o 1st Simmons
October 1844

Monday 28th

Commenced with a calm at 4 P.M. a light air from the Northward steering N S W at midnight a light breeze from N steering N W at 8 A.M. saw a right whale going quick lowered the boat without success better part fine breeze and good weather got oil water and bread

Long 72^o 18

October 1844

Tuesday 29th

Light breeze from N and good weather ship heading in different fashions saw pillars at 6 P.M. saw a right whale lowered the boat without success to near night came on board and shortened sail at daylight made all sail at 8 A.M. saw whales lowered the boat without success wild as hen hawks

Lat 33^o 10

October 1844

Wednesday the 30th

Light breeze from N and good weather saw whales lowered the boat without success at 5 P.M. saw whale lowered but no crew could not get near him came on board and shortened sail at daylight made all sail at 7 A.M. saw a right whale lowered the boat and fastened at 8 A.M. took him along side at 10 past 10 A.M. commenced cutting so ends

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Thursday the 31st

Light breeze and thick weather at 2 P.M. finished cutting at 4 P.M. wind hauled to S S W and cleared up commenced boiling middle and better part right whale and good weather no whales in sight employed in boiling
