

Ship Hibernia at Sea N^o 1 Simmons Master
November 1844

Friday the 1st
Light air from the Eastward ship heading to
the Northward saw a sail to the westward
middle and latter part fine weather but no
whales finished boiling saw 3 ships

Long 72^o 50

November

Saturday the 2nd

Light wind and good weather ship heading
to the Eastward employed in showing down
at 7 P.M. spoke ship Tripod ship of N. Haven
4 ments out 3 whales this season middle
and latter part fine weather employed in
showing down saw a ship to the windward
whaling finished showing down were
ship heading N. E. so ends

Lat 33^o 06

November 1844

Sunday the 3rd

Fine weather ship ahead whaling at 4 P.M.
got up to her saw whales toward the
South without success spoke a boat from the
ship Lucas one whale this season saw
one boat got came on board and shortened
sail for the night at day light made all sail
heading on different tack saw the Lucas cutting at
12 P.M. saw a whale lowered the boats and got
him at ends

Monday the 4th

Strong breezes and weather at 1 P.M. took
the whale along side half past 2 P.M.
Commenced cutting at 3 P.M. first best shortened
sail to double reefed topgills and commenced
boiling middle and latter part fresh breeze
and good weather saw whale going quick
to the windward lowered the boats without
success so ends Employed in boiling

Lat 32^o 54

November 1844

Tuesday the 5th

Strong and light breeze with little rain
at 3 P.M. saw a right whale going to
the windward very quick wind N. E.
steering N. by W. under whole topgills
at 6 P.M. shortened sail and headed to
the wind heading N. by W. middle part
fresh breezes and showers of rain
latter part strong breezes from S ship
heading on different tack, employed in
boiling so ends Lat 33^o 23

November 1844

Wednesday the 6th

Strong breezes from the southward ship
heading to the westward saw plenty
of fish backs at 6 P.M. finished boiling
and shortened sail for the night middle
and latter part light air and calm
employed in showing down so ends
