Light breeze from S.W. steering N.E. & employed
in spee. duty middle part fine breeze latter
part wind S.E. ship heading N.E. & employed
in different jobs the Alce in sight
Lat 33° 21'

January 1845

Wednesday the 26th

Light breeze from S.E. ship heading S.W. &
middle part wind S.W. & ship heading N.W. &
latter part wind S.W. and weather the same
painted the Labboard boat the Alce in sight
to the windward Lat 31° 57'

Long 176° 18' by 2 Lunar
176° 25' by one

January 1845

Thursday the 30th

Light breeze and good weather ship
heading N.W. & saw the Alce in sight
clear above more sperm oil, middle part
light wind heading N.W. & latter part the same
employed in different jobs Lat 30° 00'

Long 176° 25' by one

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January 1845

Friday the 31st

Light breeze from S.W. ship heading N.W. &
middle and latter part wind S.W. ship heading
S.W. & mended the Waste boat and painted her
all most calm Lat 29° 34'
