February 1845

Wednesday the 12th

Light breezes from S steering ENE with
all sail set middle part wind haul to
E by S latter part fresh breezes ship heading
N by W put on a preventer back stay
on the fore topgallant mast this Day
threw over board the Hebert
Barrel of Beef and condemned
one

by Lunar 163° 02'

February 1845

Thursday the 13th

Fresh breezes from ESE ship heading
N by E employed in ship's duty middle
and latter part fresh breezes from the land
ship heading N by E so ends

Lat 26° 03'
Long 161° 35'

February 1845

Friday the 14th

Fine breezes from the Eastward ship heading
NNW with all sail set sun white water
middle part squally ship heading N by E
latter part fresh breezes from ESE ship
heading NNW so ends Lat 23° 46'
Long 160° 50'

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February 1845

Saturday the 15th

Fresh breezes from ESE ship heading
NNW with all sail set middle
part the same at 8 o'clock steering N
not standing sails at 10 o'clock saw
Land Orange bearing N by E about
10 Leagues latter part fresh breeze ESE
steering for the land so ends

Lat 21° 34'
Long 160° 00'
Chased right by the land
5 seconds per Day
Error

February 1845

Sunday the 16th

Fine breezes from ESE at 4 o'clock the
Capt went on shore north side at 7
came on board middle part fresh and
good weather lying off Cape on
latter part Starboard Watch on liberty
employed in taking of recruits
so ends

February 1845

Monday the 17th

Fresh breezes, and good weather
his day got all our recruits 50 Bells of
sweet potatoes plenty of bananas and other
fruit at 6 o'clock watch came on board
middle part fresh breezes the ship
Procco lying on and off for recruits
17 recruits 850 sperm at 7 o'clock
Starboard watch went on shore Liberty
so ends
