February 1845

Monday the 24th

Light winds from E and fine weather ship heading N^W E with all sail set middle part the same latter part calm employed in setting up rigging no ends

February 1845

Tuesday the 25th

Light air and baffling ship heading from N^W to N^E at 6 P^M 3 whirling winds passed close to the ship cleared up foggy weather middle and latter part light air and calm employed in turning in fore rigging saw a Dory steering N^W

February 1845

Wednesday the 26

Light breezes from N^E ship heading N^W by N at 7 P^M heading N^W middle part N^E wind E by S latter part the same employed in setting and taring rigging got out water

by Sun at 155ⁿ 41

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Thursday the 27th

Light breezes and squally ship heading N^E by N middle part squally with heavy thunder and rain latter part the same ship heading to the N^W by N

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Friday the 28th

Light breezes from N^E ship heading N^W by N middle and latter part the same employed in fitting and taring rigging
