March 1845

Thursday the 13th
Light breezes and pleasant weather heading E & S
by 10 P.M. tacked ship heading NW & W latter part
light breezes and fine weather ship heading NW & W
Lat 4° 07'
Long 158° 33' W
Lunar 158° 33' Lunar

March 1845
Friday the 14th
Light breezes and pleasant weather heading
NW & W to S & S by 10 tacked to the E by 10 middle
part wind N & E tacked to NW & W latter part heading
NW & E and N & E employed in ship duty
Lat 9° 10'
Long 158° 37'

March 1845
Saturday the 15th
Light winds and good weather ship heading
NW & W all sail set caught a porpoise
Cook sick middle and latter part wind
and weather the same ship heading NW & E
got out water 30 Lat 11° 17'

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Sunday the 16th
Light breezes from E ship heading NW & E
under all sail middle and latter part
of the 24 hours light E & S winds
and pleasant weather ship heading
N & E by N Lat 13° 25'
Long by Chron 159° 50'
Lunar 158° 00'

March 1845
Monday the 17th
Commenced with light breezes and pleasant
weather ship heading NW & E by N and NW & E
middle and latter part wind E & S & E
ship heading NW & E with fine weather
employed in sundries Lat 15° 09'
Long by Chron 156° 34'
Chron Lunar 156° 31'
Lunar Lunar 156° 38'

March 1845
Tuesday the 18th
Fine breezes from E & S ship heading
NW & E with all sail set by Cook very
sick with the cramp middle and latter
part fine breezes at 8 P.M. set shrouding
sails steering NW & E wind E & E employed
in varnishing masts Lat 17° 08'
Long 153° 00'
