March 1845

Monday the 24th Civil Account
This day scraped and painted the bents the
Starboard watch shore on liberty about 12
ships came in at 7 P.M. Watch came on board
ends with fine weather

March 1845

Tuesday the 25th

This day brook out our meat found 7 stinkin
out of 38 and sold it to the Huntress at 2 per lb
Starboard watch shore on liberty at 7 P.M. came on board
this day ends well

March 1845

Wednesday the 26th

This day fine weather employed in salting our
meat Starboard watch shore at 7 P.M. the
watch came on board this day ends with good
weather

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Thursday the 27th
This day employed in stowing down meat
the Starboard Watch shore at 7 P.M.
came on board sent ashore 4 Pipes of
Bread condemned 2 bbls of Beef
this day ends with good weather

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Friday the 28th

This day sent 900 cask ashore for water
Starboard Watch shore on liberty at
7 P.M. came on board this day ends
with good weather
Shipped a Portugee by the name of Manuel

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Saturday the 29th

This day got off 100 bbls of water and
stowed it down in the lower hold
Starboard Watch shore at 7 P.M. came on
board this day ends well
56 ships at anchor
