March 1845

Sunday 20th

Thursday 30th
This day good weather all hands went ashore
but one boats crew & sun down came on
board this day cuts well ships coming and
going

March 1845

Monday the 31th

This day good weather took a raft of casks
shore Labrador West shore at 17 S. E.
came on board this day and well

Lying at anchor at Moore's Sandwich Islands

April 1845.

Tuesday the 1st.

This day good weather got off 100 lbs of water
shoved some of it sent a small raft shore
I Watched there in liberty at 7 o'clock came
on board this day ends well ship coming
and going

April 1845

Wednesday the 2th

This day good weather got of the best of
our water and returned it below without
much on liberty of 7 P.M. came on board
this day and so well

April 1843 -

Thurs day the 3th

commences with fresh breezes at 3 A.M.
found the ship dragging got hawled off the
Jefferson or Jeffersonian stern her foremast
board a little got clear of her, let go the
foreboard anchor and hove up the Stubbard
anchor and hauled it board got 40 lbs of potatoes
at 4 P.M. wind fresh let go the Stubbard anchor
the Stubbard Watch went on shore and came
up at 7 P.M. this day ends well
