

Lying at Anchor at Moore Sandwich Islands

April 1845

Friday the 4th

This morning hove up the Stubbards anchor
the Labboard watch went shore, strong winds
from N.W. & 2 ships dragged out several lying with
both anchors ship Hibernia lying with one anchor
70 fathom of chain in 20 fathom water at 7 P.M. the
Watch came on board with Silvey and Carpenter
doubled reefed the topsails and got ready for
slipping wind moderating but strong in places
this day ends in a calm
Died a 3d Mate Mr. McCoose
Mr. Benjamin McCoose

April 1845

Saturday the 5th

This day fine weather Stubbards Watch shore
stowed off between decks at 7 P.M. the watch
came on board over Carpenter and Puertogues
Silvey not on board yet this day ends well

April 1845

Sunday the 6th

This day fine weather Labboard watch shore
at 7 P.M. all came on board but Charles Watson
several ships left 2 came in this day ends well

April 1845

Monday the 7th

This day fine weather at 10 A.M. the boat came off
and brought the Carpenter and Charles Watson
put the Carpenter in Irons stowed the Stubbards
Anchor the Carpenter was hit in the rigging and
flagged for running away

April 1845

Tuesday the 8th Sea Account

At 2 P.M. hove up anchor and got
under weigh at 3 P.M. Capt came on
board and kept off. shifted a Native
stowed the Labboard anchor but kept the
cable bent middle part good brace from
the mast at 8 A.M. off Harbor Harbor 10 miles
the Capt went shore light airs several ships
in at anchor some lying off and on
this day ends well lying off and on so ends

April 1845

Wednesday the 9th

Pleasant breeze and fine weather at 7 P.M.
the Boat came on board squared away steering
W.W.W. for 6 to 8 miles part light breeze
later part fresh 5 ships in sight so ends
At 10 P.M. Bearing W.W.W. distance 12 miles

April 1845

Thursday the 10th

At 2 P.M. the Capt went ashore at 6 P.M.
the boat came off with yards lying off and
on the Capt shore to forward of the middle
part good weather at 10 A.M. sent 2 boats shore
and one lb of flour one of oil and some cloth
one ship came so ends this day
