June 1845

Sunday the 1st

Cicero N Bedford
3 whales

A gale from the southward ship heading
E under short sail middle part weather
the same at 4 A.M. made sail and kept her
up to 9 A.M. spoke the Cicero of N Bedford
3 whales latter part wind and weather
the same

Lat 53° 36'
Long 16° 50'

June 1845

Monday the 2nd

Ben Morgan & Son
1 whale

Strong breezes from the westward steering
to the eastward saw a whale at 8 P.M. spoke
in the main topgallant sail middle part moderated
a little at day light saw 2 right whales lowered
2 boats without success at 7 A.M. spoke the
Benjamin Morgan of London, 4 whales saw
her boat kept to a northward at 8 A.M. came
on to blow from the southward with rain
fog in fore and main topsails at 9 A.M.
during strong easterly the main topsail took
in the fore sail as said
do not think the B.M. saved her whale

June 1845

Tuesday the 3rd

A gale from the southward ship heading E & S
under short reefed main top sail at day light
weather no better kept her up to the
eastward employed in setting up near
like shacks to put water in saw whales

Lat 54° 0'
Long 15° 41'

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Wednesday the 4th

Light gales and bad weather employed
in breaking and civil staying half fore
sail between decks steering to the
eastward middle and latter part weather
the same no whales Lat 54° 16'
Long 15° 40'

June 1845

Thursday the 5th

A gale from the westward steering
to the eastward employed in shelling
water into pipes at 6 P.M. fell
in with whales rose the sails to
at day light and doubled reefed topsails saw
2 whales lowered without success latter
part light gales and thick weather
No O's

June 1845

Friday the 6th

Moderate gales and thick weather most
of the time at 6 P.M. saw plenty whales
saw to under short sail ship heading
W wind to the southward middle part
moderated to light breezy with rain and
snow at 7 A.M. set of sails reefed topsails
saw whales lowered the boat without success
wind hauled to the northward and freshened

Long 15° 16'
