September 1845

Sunday the 28th
Light air and calm middle part calm latter
part a light breeze from ESE steering ship SSW
set fore topmast and main topgallant & taking sails
Lat 38° 58'

September 1845
Monday the 29th

Light breezes from the Eastward and good weather
steering SSW bent the main royal and set it
middle and top part fine breezes from ESE
steering SSW employed in repairing fly jib and
making bean spinnaker &c
Lat 37° 18'

September 1845
Tuesday the 30th and last

Fine breeze and good weather from ESE steering
SSW middle and latter part wind N'E steering
SSW and S by W employed in repairing fly jib
and making bean spinnaker &c ends
Lat 35° 40'
Long 144° 17'

Wednesday the 1st
Fine breezes from NW steering S by W
all hands employed in drying bean making
spinnaker and other necessary work middle
and latter part wind and weather the same
patched the old boat
Lat 34° 04'

October
September 1845
Thursday the 2nd

Fine breezes and good weather from N'E
steering S by W employed in bundling bean
middle and latter part light air and calm
got out the old boat
Lat 33° 05'

October 1845
Friday the 3rd

Light breezes and good weather steering SSW
employed in drying bean and bundling it one
man at the mast head say five sacks middle
part light breezes latter part the same this day
finished our bean &c ends
Lat 32° 11'
Long 146° 45'
