

Ship Hibernia at the Sandwich Islands

October 1845

Wednesday the 22nd

Fresh breeze and rain squalls latter line got new
pipes ashore and killed them & water. Some carpenter
on board at work watch employed in painting spar
and filling water &c watch came on board

October 1845

Thursday the 23rd

This day got off 160 lbs of water stored some air
clean head spit and washed bend painting spar
carpenter at work watch was ashore &c

October 1845

Friday the 24th

This day rain squalls painted one side of the
sends and some of the spars headed spit and
scraped the other side. Carpenter on board at
work watch ashore &c

October 1845

Saturday the 25th

Fresh part rain squalls latter part fine weather
painted the bend finished the spar and
painted the stern watch ashore carpenter work
filling water &c watch came on board

October 1845

Sunday the 26th

Fine weather some of the crew ashore to Church

October 1845

Monday the 27th

Watch employed in painting ship one watch
ashore on liberty carpenter at work on board

October 1845

Tuesday the 28th

This day stowed water watch ashore employed
in painting ship &c
