

Ship Hibernia at the S & M Simmons

October 1845

Wednesday the 29th

This day got a salt of water and painted ship
caught standing sails bams wood (re Charles & others
absent)

October 1845

Thursday the 30th

This day all hands employed in getting
off provisions and small stores 3 sets of oars
100 feet of lead, 4 boats of canvas 15 lbs
of Irish potatoes 4 lbs of onion sent ashore 5 lbs
of oil the Carpenter finished repairing ship 27
days per single man

October 1845

Friday the 31st

This day all hands employed in getting off
provisions 5 lbs of 3/4 lb beef 6 lbs of sweet potatoes
2 new boats 5 casks of damaged local brand
at auction painted the ship banded the 2nd time
Oren Dimond and Charles Chase departed

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Saturday the 1st November 1845

This day got a store and 14 lbs of beef
from ship Congaree from above last
watch shore fine weather

November 1845

Sunday the 2nd

This day fine weather some of the ship
company shore to Church

November 1845

Monday the 3rd

Fine weather watch shore employed in
painting waterways and fitting boat
