

Ship Hibernia at Sea M^{rs} Simmons Mrs

November 1845

Saturday the 22th

Light breeze and good weather employed in repairing
sails middle and latter part the same at 6 o'clock
saw a school of porpoises. The boats going quick
to the windward hauled back without success
at 5 PM

November 1845

Sunday the 23th

Light breeze and hazy with some rain
middle part calm latter part the same cleared
saw sails so ends Lat 24 53
Long 153 58

November 1845

Monday the 24th

Light air and calm, and clear weather middle
and latter part light breeze and fine weather
employed in repairing sails Lat 24 17

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Tuesday the 25th

Light breeze from the Eastward and good
weather ship heading to the southward middle
and latter part the same employed in repairing
sails caught 9 porpoises so ends Lat 24 18

November 1845

Wednesday the 26th

Small breeze from S E and fine weather
at 9 o'clock tackel ship heading E by N at
10 o'clock to S E W middle and latter
part the same saw grampuses Lat 24 36

November 1845

Thursday the 27th

Light breeze and good weather ship heading
S E by S employed in repairing fore sail middle
and latter part wind and weather the same
ship heading S W Lat 24 47
