November 1845

Friday the 28th
Light breeze from S.E. and fine weather ship heading
S.W. by S employed in sail mending middle and latter
part wind and weather the same

Lat 2^h 53'
Long 153^h 01'

November 1845

Saturday the 29th

Light breeze from S.E. by S ship heading S.W. employed
in repairing sails middle and latter part the same
bent the old fore sail main sail and Lat 2^h 20'
fore by haul showed the new ones better

November 1845

Sunday the 30th

First part calm at 6 P.M. slight breeze from
E by S ship heading S.E. latter part the same ship
heading S.E. by E

Lat 1^h 28'
Long 154^h 56'

Ship Hibernia at Sea Board for M^r Gifford

December 1845

Monday the 1st
Light breeze from E ship heading S.E.
middle part and latter the same employed in
repairing old sails so ends Lat 00^h 04' 01"

December 1845

Tuesday the 2nd

Light breeze from E by S ship heading S.E.
bent the old jib got out water middle and
latter part the same bent in the Starboard head
to repair water employed in repairing sails

Lat 01^h 57' South

December 1845

Wednesday the 3rd

Light breeze from E and fine weather ship
heading S.E. by E part of S.E. bent the old
main topmast sail middle part equally with
main latter part fine breeze from W.E. Starboard
S.E. by S and Starboard water employed in fitting
rigging so ends Lat 2^h 48' 00" Long
