

Ship *Hibernia* at Sea Board South

December 1845

Wednesday the 10th

Fine breezes from E & good weather -
steering S with all sail set middle and latter
part wind and weather the same employed in fitting
rigging so ends Lat 13° 30'
Long 152° 35'

December 1845

Thursday the 11th

Fine breezes and weather steering S S W wind
E & middle and latter part wind and weather
the same employed in fitting rigging Lat 15° 24'
Long 153° 44'

December 1845

Friday the 12th

Fine breezes from E & good weather -
steering S S W with all sail set middle
part the same stayed aboard one hour before daylight
on account of land latter part fine weather
employed in fitting rigging Lat 16° 47'

December 1845

Saturday the 13th

Fine breezes and rain squalls from E & steering
S W by S all sail set middle part the same
set lower stay sail latter part squalls carried away fore topmast & sub-
-ing sail brace wind backing and plenty of rain Lat 17° 06'

December 1845

Sunday the 14th

Good part calm and rain at 5 P.M. a light breeze
from E & steering S W by S middle part light breeze
latter part the same from the Northward Lat 18° 35'

December 1845

Monday the 15th

First part light air from the Northward steering
S W by S with all sail set middle part and
latter the same steering S W by W the day steamed
down our stern sail and engaged 20 bbls of Wood
that is not come Lat 18° 57'
