

Ship Hibernia at Port of Pigeon

December 1845

Monday the 22nd

Light breeze and falling at 7 P.M. hauled all on board middle part light air and a strong current at 7 P.M. hauled a barrel for shore ship. East side of the river our landing place at both sides at 11 P.M. hauled came on board one with wood and 2 with water 45 lbs each no ends

December 1845

Tuesday the 23rd

Light breeze from N.W. and good weather Boat went ashore East side got 2 loads of wood and fruit at 7 P.M. all on board squared away steering S.W. in company with the Citizen middle part calm most of the time latter part light breeze and good weather all hands employed in stowing wood and water middle part light air latter part light breeze

December 1845

Wednesday the 24th

Light breezes and pleasant weather steering N.W. wind S.E. in company with the Citizen sea and Lat 21.30

December 1845

Thursday the 25th

Light breeze and pleasant weather steering N.W. hauled all sail wind S.E. at 1 P.M. hauled 2 S.E. and stowing sails middle and latter part the same Lat 22.00

December 1845

Friday the 26th

Light breeze from the Eastward steering N.W. employed in fitting and setting up rigging middle part wind hauled N.W. latter part the same breeze in sight steering the same Lat 23.00

December 1845

Saturday the 27th

Light breeze from E.S.E. steering N.W. hauled sail middle and latter part wind and weather the same employed in fitting and setting up rigging the Citizen in sight Lat 24.00
