December 1845

Tuesday the 28th

Fine breeze from ESE and good weather at 3
PM saw the E. whaling fleet the ship for her
saw her boat lowered, our boat without success
we got one small whale middle and latter part
wind and weather the same
L 28.00

December 1845

Monday the 29th

Fine breeze and good weather steering S 7/8 W
middle and latter part wind and weather the same
with employed in ship day started near and
L 16.00

December 1845

Tuesday the 30th

Fine breeze from E and cloudy weather all sail
set steering S 7/8 W middle part the same
latter part squally with rain saw a water spout

December 1845

Wednesday the 31st and last

Fresh breeze from E at 11 PM hauled to S 7/8 W
course middle and latter part light breezes
and good weather
L 26.04
Log 163.78

Ship Hibernia at Sea W. Hemisphere

January 1846

Thursday the 1st

Light breeze from ESE and fine weather steering
S 7/8 W all sail set watch employed in ship
light middle and latter part light air from
the westward steering S Lat 27.00
repairing sail

January 1846

Friday the 2nd

First part light airs from the westward
and fine weather steering S middle
part the same latter part abreeze from the
NW and cloudy weather Lat 27.40
repairing sail

January the 3rd 1846

Saturday the 3rd

First part fresh breezes from the westward
steering S saw white water middle and
latter part fresh breezes from the westward
employed in repairing old sail
Lat 29.56
