

Ship Hibernia at Sea New Zealand

January the 23rd 1846

Friday the 23rd

A gale from the Northward ship heading to the westward at 6 P.M. set double reefed main top-sail moderating middle and latter part a gale ship heading N.W. Lat 48° 39'

January 1846

Saturday the 24th

A gale from N.W. at 5 P.M. wind backed to W. and clear weather moderating at daylight fresh breeze and ruggid mist sail latter part strong breeze from the westward steering S.E. saw nothing

Lat 48° 54'

Long 161° 00'

January 1846

Sunday the 25th

Strong breezes from the Westward steering S.E. at 7 P.M. double reefed the top-sail for the night middle and latter part strong breezes steering N.E. nothing in sight

Lat 49° 42'

Long 161° 00'

Ship Hibernia at Sea Cruising

January 1846

Monday the 26th

Strong breezes from W. and S.W. steering S.E. at 7 P.M. closed reefed the main top-sail and sailed to the westward heading off S.W. gale commencing middle part blowing fresh latter part strong breezes made off sail steering S.E. to end Lat 48° 58'

Long 156° 40'

January 1846

Tuesday the 27th

Strong breezes and gale after steering S.E. at 7 P.M. shortened sail for the night heading N.W. & middle part strong breezes at daylight made sail at 7 A.M. kept her W. made all sail latter part fresh breezes from W. and cloudy weather

Lat 48°

January 1846

Wednesday the 28th

A light gale from W. steering N.E. double reefed top-sail at 5 P.M. bore to under close reefed main top-sail heading N.W. middle part a gale wind S.W. latter part moderated made sail steering S.E. nothing in sight

Lat 48° 25'

Long 153° 30'
