Light breeze from ESE steering W by N  
several sail in sight steering the same  
middle and latter part the same employed  
in fitting rigging

Fine breeze from ESE steering W by N  
sail and exchange signals with the  
Falcon at 11<sup>o</sup> 33 m<sup>o</sup> 22 o'clock  
of it being at 2 P.M. spoke her middle  
last weather the same latter part fresh breeze

April 18<sup>th</sup> 46

Saturday the 18<sup>th</sup>

Light and fresh from the Eastward  
steering W by N E 3 sail in sight middle  
and latter part squally and rain winds  
bustling so ends

April 18<sup>th</sup> 46

Sunday the 19<sup>th</sup>  
Light breeze from the Eastward and  
squally with rain steering W by N  
all sail set 3 sail and land in sight  
middle part a ship bore from SE by E  
ship bearing W by N at daylight  
land 12 miles off may be seen at  
8 A.M. about 10 P.M. saw  
several sail at anchor latter part  
fine breeze and good weather steering  
W by N along with the land

Lat 7<sup>o</sup> 40  
Long 34<sup>o</sup> 45

April 19<sup>th</sup> 46

Monday the 20<sup>th</sup>

Fine breeze from SE steering W by N  
at sun down land 12 miles off bearing  
W 30 miles bearing W by N middle  
and latter part fresh breeze with a grass  
topmast standing sail saw a ship steering  
W so ends

Lat 4<sup>o</sup> 56

April 19<sup>th</sup> 46

Tuesday the 21<sup>st</sup>

Fine breeze from SE and good  
winds employed in fitting rigging  
at 2 P.M. spoke the Abigail Vernon  
middle part squally with rain take in  
the light sail latter part fresh breeze from  
SE steering W by N all sail set
