c April 1846

Wednesday the 22nd

Light breezes from S & E and cloudy weather
employed in fitting rigging sent a new lower
standing sail middle part the same latter part
breezes light from S & E to S & E and up the foremast
rigging to ends

Lat 30° 25' N
Long 33° 30' W

c April 1846

Thursday the 23rd

Light breezes from S & E steering N all
sail, set middle part the same at 10 AM
equally empty breezes latter part light airs and
calms land plenty of rain

c April 1846

Friday the 24th

Light airs and calms and over middle
and latter part light airs and brollings
employed in fitting rigging

Lat 30° 43' N
Long 33° 40' W

c April 1846

Saturday the 25th

Light airs from the Eastward steering N
all sail set middle and latter part
light airs from the Eastward steering N all
employed in tapping in the chain rigging
to ends

c April 1846

Sunday the 26th

Light airs from the Eastward steering
N all sail set middle and latter
part brollings wind and rain equal

Lat 30° 5'

c April 1846

Monday the 27th

Light breezes from N & E steering N all
sail a sail steering the same middle and
latter part fresh with rain equal
employed in fitting rigging
