

Ship Hikoria at Sea near Gulf Stream

May 1846

Saturday the 16th

Light breeze from S E and fine weather
steering N by W all sail set and a Barque
steering S the cutter and middle and latter
part the same

Lat 33° 57'
Long 68° 50'

May the 1846

Sunday the 17th

All the 24 hours fresh breeze from S E
and good weather steering N by W

Lat 33° 12'
Long 69° 47' 1/2
Three 10 a m S E 1/2 W

May 1846

Monday the 18th

Light breeze from S E and fine weather
steering N by W a Barque passed us
steering N by W middle part light latter
part fine breeze from S E steering N by E
washed ship but sail

Lat 33° 31'
Long 71° 00'

Ship Hikoria on the Coast of America

May 1846

Tuesday the 19th

Light breeze from S E steering N by W
at 4 P M came in thick fog at 5 P M
wind hauled to N W and squally. Took in sail
at 10 P M. Morning fresh still kept the main
top sail and ship heading N N W at day light
more moderate made sail at 10 a m. At 11 a m
light from a warm ship made all sail heading
E by N

Lat 40° 20'
Long 74° 00'

May 1846

Wednesday the 20th

Light breeze from N W steering N E by N
all sail set at 8 P M spoke a Brig
Alabama of N York same time saw
Black & heading N W by distance 20 miles
and several hail middle part the same
latter part fresh breeze from S W at 8 P M
got a field at 11 P M came to an anchor

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
