

Arrived on board Ship Hibernia of New Bedford

Saturday Nov 26th Commences with pleasant weather and a fine breeze had a gain with the Gauge Mast saw finbacks the Larva of New Bedford run down and Capt Green went on board of the Washon Lat 45.24

Sunday Nov 27th Thick and foggy with light winds took in sail and set the watch middle part thick fog latter part pleasant with fine weather saw finbacks Lat 45.56 Sth

Monday Nov 28th Pleasant with a fine breeze from the S West steering S E as a course saw finbacks at sunset took in all sail but close reefed main topsail latter part a gale from the Westward ship bore too nothing seen Lat by Obs 46.45 Sth Long ...

Tuesday Nov 29th Commences with a gale the ship bore too under the staysail middle more moderate latter part pleasant with a fine breeze carried away the flyjibb boom saved the whole of it rigging Lat 46.33 Sth

Wednesday Nov 30th Commences with a strong breeze from the Northward saw plenty of finbacks watches engaged in making sunset at sunset took in sail middle and latter part a gale from the N the at 8 P M the bolt that held the spanker gaff gave way the gaff came on deck Lat 46.54 Sth

Thursday Dec 1st Commences with rather more pleasant weather but a very heavy swell watches engaged in mending the spanker and getting the gaff up again got all aloft by 1 P M latter part pleasant saw finbacks Lat 46.53 Sth

Friday Dec 2nd Commences with light air and calms ship heading to the Westward on the wind saw a Barque to the seaward latter part pleasant with a fine breeze spoke the Ship Condor of New Bedford 68 days from home had a gain Lat 46 02

Saturday Dec 3rd Commences with fine weather and a fine breeze saw two ships and Porpoises in air in company with the Condor latter part wind and weather the same signalled the Abraham Baker Lat 46.32 Sth

Sunday Dec 4th Pleasant weather and a fine breeze ship heading various courses the Condor in sight at sunset she came down and Capt came on board and spent the evening middle and latter part pleasant saw another gain off the lee beam Lat 45.45 Sth

Monday Dec 5th Pleasant with a fine breeze saw the Ship Athello 4 months out with 200 sperm middle part a gale from the Southward with squalls latter part pleasant with light breezes saw two sails and finbacks No Obs

Tuesday Dec 6th Commences with pleasant weather and a fine breeze from the N the steering to the N West saw two sails and finbacks middle and latter part pleasant with a fine breeze from the Northward saw two sails watches engaged in making sunset Lat 46.15 Sth Long 59.06 Wth
