

Remarks on board Ship Milernia of New Bedford

Sunday Dec 18th Commences with pleasant weather and a fine breeze from the S S W ship on the wind saw jammers and a sail steering to the Nth W. Mr Saunders has not done anything for three months his legs are so bad middle and latter part pleasant with light air and calms saw killers and porpoise and two sails

Monday Dec 19th Pleasant with a fine breeze from the S S W ship heading to the Northward and Eastward saw a ship supposed to be the Holmoch middle and latter part pleasant latter part thick fog nothing seen etc etc

Tuesday Dec 20th Pleasant with a fine breeze from the Northward ship heading to the Westward saw three sail and some Grampas the Barque Andrews passed us about 3 A M steering to the S S W middle and latter part pleasant with a fine breeze from the S S W at 7 P M spoke the Ship Metacomb of New Bedford clean Woodrige Master at 10 P M spoke the Ship Robert Edwards of New Bedford 120 bbls taken lately Kelly Master Lat 45° 29' Sth Long 57° 08' W

Wednesday Dec 21st Commences with pleasant weather and a fine breeze from the Westward steering to the Southward the Robert Edwards in sight nothing else seen ship going under easy sail with light winds middle part pleasant saw one finback latter part strong breeze from the S S W nothing seen etc etc to day

Tuesday Dec 22nd Commences with light winds and pleasant weather saw one finback and some porpoise watches engaged in making sunset middle and latter part pleasant with light air and calms saw grampas and one sail Lat 45° 39' Sth

Wednesday Dec 23rd Commences with pleasant weather and a light air from the Westward saw one sail I have a bad pain in my breast and have had for four or five days past and there is three or four men with the same complaint Mr Sheffield with a headache made a fly jib boom today out of the lower wing boom middle and latter part pleasant with light air saw five sail all hands engaged in lining the new sails and the sticingsails Lat 45° 45' Sth Long 58° 59' W

Thursday Dec 24th Pleasant with light breezes two sail running for as the Barque Andrews is one of them middle and latter part pleasant with a fine breeze in company with the Ship Adeline Gibbs and the Barque Andrews sent out the fly jib boom Lat 46° 32' Sth Long 58° 54' W

Friday Dec 25th Commences with pleasant weather and spoke the Ship Adeline Gibbs of Fair Haven clean latter part pleasant with a fine breeze Lat 47° 45' Sth in company with William Wait and St George

Saturday Dec 26th Pleasant with a strong breeze from the S S W ship heading to the S S E on the wing at 6 A M tacked ship heading to the Westward the Adeline Gibbs and the Wm Wait in sight middle and latter part pleasant with a strong breeze from the S S W the Ship Adeline Gibbs in company saw another sail Lat 47° 29' Sth
