Tuesday March 7th Commences with a fine breeze from the Sth East course Wt by Nth 1st watches engaged in ships Duties making spungam and rime drawing yams knots groans and filling ship latter part squally with a fine breeze from the Sth course Wt by Nth Lat by Nth

Wednesday March 8th Commences with squally weather and a fine breeze from the Sth course Wt by Nth watches engaged in various Duties saw finbacks latter part pleasant with a light breeze from the Sth course Wt by Nth Nothing seen Lat 16° 58' Sth

Thursday March 9th Commences with pleasant weather and a fine breeze from the Sth course Nth Wt by Nth under all sail nothing seen tonight put Thompson in Steward and Smith in cook latter part pleasant wind and course the same watches engaged in tarring down and making spungam

Friday March 10th Pleasant with a fine breeze from the Sth East course Nth Wt by Nth all sail set latter part pleasant wind from the Sth course Nth Wt by Nth watches engaged in ramshing the masts and making spungam Lat 16° 58' Sth

Saturday March 11th Commences with pleasant weather and a fine breeze from the Sth course Nth Wt by Nth all sail set latter part pleasant wind and course the same watches engaged in tarring down and filling the ship Lat 17° 36'

Sunday March 12th Pleasant weather and a fine breeze from the Sth course Nth Wt by Nth watches engaged in various Duties latter part squally with the wind and course the same nothing seen Lat 17° 01' Sth

Monday March 13th Commences with squally weather and a fine breeze from the Sth East course Nth Wt all sail out latter part thick and foggy with a fine breeze from the Sth course Wt by Nth all sail out Nth

Tuesday March 14th Commences with thick nasty weather and a fine breeze from the Sth course Wt by Nth with rain saw porpoises struck two but did not save them latter part thick and foggy with rain Nth

Wednesday March 15th Commences with thick foggy weather and a fine breeze from the Sth course Wt by Nth Antonio Fiel's sick with the venereal and has been for one week past latter part thick rainy weather nothing doing nothing seen Nth

Thursday March 16th Commences with thick squally weather nothing doing nothing seen latter part squally with rain course Wt by Nth Nth Lat Long 112 West

Friday March 17th Commences with thick rainy weather and a fine breeze from the Eastward course Wt by Nth nothing doing nothing seen latter part pleasant with a fine breeze from the Eastward Cartwright sick Freeman and Richard sick

Saturday March 18th Commences with a fine breeze from the Eastward course Wt by Nth watches engaged in various Duties latter part thick foggy weather
