

Remarks on board Ship *Hibernia* of New Bedford

Sunday March 19th Commences with squally weather and a fine breeze from the S.E. course West saw nothing latter part weather squally with a fine breeze from the S.E. course N.W. nothing seen Lat 2.46 Sth

Monday March 20th Commences with squally weather and variable winds course N.W. by N.W. nothing seen latter part pleasant with a light breeze from the S.E. course N.W. all sail set caught a Porpoise Lat 00.46

Tuesday March 21st Commences with pleasant weather and light breezes from the Eastward course N.W. by N.W. broke out Slops latter part pleasant with light air from various quarters watches engaged in various duties nothing seen Lat 00.14 Sth

Wednesday March 22nd Commences with pleasant weather and light breezes from the Eastward watches engaged in making spinnycorn and setting up shooks latter part pleasant with light air and calms watches engaged in tarring down and varnishing the Mast Lat by Ob 46 Nth Long by Chron 123.21 by Luner 123.21 123.24 123.18

Thursday March 23rd Commences with pleasant weather and light air and calms from various quarters saw Blackfish covered with mucus also saw Porpoises and a shark latter part light air and calms with heavy rain showers Lat 1 09

Sunday March 24th Commences with squally weather and light baffling winds at 6 A.M. got a light breeze from the N.E. course N.W. by N.W. standing sails set at 7 A.M. by a heavy squall and carried away the fly jib boom saved all kept the ship N.W. took in the standing sails and light sails at 8 A.M. set the topgallant sail. latter part pleasant with light breezes from the N.E. all sail set Lat by Ob 2.54 Sth

Saturday March 25th Pleasant with a fine breeze from the N.E. course N.W. watches engaged in sending in the jib boom and sending out another boom got it out and all made fast for the night so ends latter part pleasant with light breeze from the N.E. course N.W. by Ob Lat 4.30 Long 127.45 Wth

Sunday March 26th Commences with pleasant weather and a light breeze from the N.E. steering various courses saw Porpoises latter part pleasant with a fine breeze course W.N.W. all sail set Lat 6.06 Sth

Monday March 27th Commences with a fine breeze and pleasant weather course W.N.W. latter part the same watches engaged in various duties Lat 7.50

Tuesday March 28th Commences with pleasant weather and a fine breeze from the N.E. course W by Nth latter part pleasant with a fine breeze from the N.E. course W by Nth Lat 8.11
