

Tuesday August 4th Pleasant with a fine breeze went up the Bay with two boats to be sure if there was any whales or not latter part the same

Saturday August 5th Pleasant Boats off looking for whales went up the Bay to trade got some fish and one Deer

Sunday August 6th Pleasant two Boats off looking for whales latter part the same saw no whales

Monday August 7th Pleasant the Capt off looking for whales the other Boats on board latter part pleasant got the ship under way and stood out with the tide till it turned then let go the anchor engaged in ships duty

Tuesday August 8th Pleasant saw a few whales latter part pleasant Boats off chasing whales saw plenty but could not get fast moved the ship farther out of the Bay

Wednesday August 9th Commences with pleasant weather Boats off chasing whales middle part thunder and lightning with rain latter part fine weather Boats chasing whales

Thursday August 10th Pleasant Boats chasing whales nothing doing on board latter part the same

Friday August 11th Pleasant Boats off chasing whales middle and latter part thick fog nothing doing

Saturday Aug 12th Thick fog nothing doing latter part the same three Boats off chasing whales without success so ends

In Thantar Bay looking for whales

Sunday August 13th Commences with thick fog and rain three Boats off chasing without success latter part the same

Monday August 14th Strong breeze with rain boat chasing whales latter part fine weather Boats off chasing without success

Tuesday August 15 Fine weather and a fine breeze Boats off chasing whales latter part the same hour up the anchor and stood up the Bay to look for wood and water

Wednesday August 16th Pleasant iship up the Bay getting wood and water latter part the same

Thursday August 17th Pleasant weather ship laying up the Bay in 7 fathoms water with forty five fathoms of chain cut all hands getting off wood and water and cutting spars

Friday August 18th Pleasant getting off wood and water latter part the same

Saturday August 19th Getting off wood and spars latter part refused to work and so we done nothing

Sunday August 20th Nothing doing but sleeping and eating 21st Commences with fine weather but nothing doing latter part got off all the wood that we could stow

22nd Commences with pleasant weather got the ship under way and it came on to blow and we had to run back and anchor

23rd Thick rainy weather and blowing fresh four boats from other ships on board

24th Thick nasty weather and a strong breeze six boats on board from other ships latter part thick fog here up the Anchor and stand out the Bay and come to an anchor at 11 AM
