

Ship Hibernia laying to an anchor in the Bay  
Friday 25th August Pleasant weather and nothing doing  
and no whales in the Bay and most  
of the ships leaving latter part the same

Saturday Aug 26th Pleasant with a fine breeze latter part  
blowing strong gave the ship eighty  
fathoms of chain at daylight got under  
way and stood out of the Bay

Sunday Aug 27th Pleasant with light airs ship headed  
to the N E latter part thick fog  
ship heading to the N E

Monday Aug 28th Commences with pleasant weather  
and a fine breeze heard one whale  
saw one ship boiling and three doing  
nothing latter part pleasant with light  
airs and calms steering to the N E East  
saw two ships but no whales watches  
engaged in clearing bone

Tuesday August 29th Pleasant with light airs and calms  
engaged in scraping and clearing bone  
Capt Laundry came on board from the  
Ship Scene of New Bedford 11 months  
out 350 lbs latter part pleasant with  
light airs and calms stood in for Jan

Wednesday August 30th Pleasant the Capt lowered the Boat  
and went ashore at Jan after charts  
latter part came off and got up the  
Chain and came to an anchor in  
twenty one fathoms water and gave  
her about 90 fathoms of chain

Thursday August 31st Pleasant Boats off chasing whales  
without success one ship went out of  
a Brig came in latter part pleasant  
called all hands at 3 P M and got  
Breakfast then went off after whales  
latter part pleasant at 3 P M the  
Starboard Boat struck killed and  
towed but the tide was so strong we  
had to anchor

Port of Jan whaling for Bow Heads got two 200 lbs  
Friday Sept 1st Pleasant with a fine breeze got the whale  
alongside at 5 A M and got already for  
cutting then got supper and set the watch  
for the night latter part fine weather called  
all hands and hove in the whale got through  
at 12 noon and got dinner

Saturday Sept 2nd Commences with fine weather and a good  
breeze watches engaged in boiling and clearing  
up the decks our pot broke latter part  
pleasant engaged in boiling and chasing whales

Sunday Sept 3rd Pleasant chasing whales and boiling latter  
part the same

Monday Sept 4th Commences with pleasant weather  
finished boiling and washed off decks  
turned up 90 lbs on deck latter  
part Boats off chasing whales

Tuesday Sept 5th Pleasant with a very heavy sea running  
latter part more moderate chasing whales

Wednesday Sept 6th Pleasant Bow Boat struck and killed  
him and commenced towing at 11 A M  
run the line to the Berque Turber  
and made fast for the night latter

part pleasant run the line to our  
ship and hauled him alongside and  
all hands turned in

Thursday Sept 7th Pleasant commenced cutting finished  
at 10 A M and got supper and all  
hands turned in latter part pleasant  
with a strong breeze from the N W  
cleared away the head and started the  
works engaged in boiling

Friday Sept 8th Pleasant with a strong breeze from  
the N W engaged in boiling latter  
part more moderate engaged in  
boiling and steering down
